

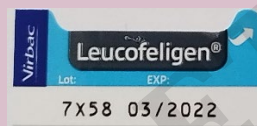
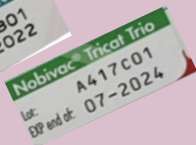
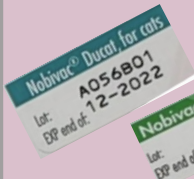


Cat Vaccination Schedule

1st primary vaccination

At 8 - 9 weeks old (or on a vaccination restart)

Vaccinations need to cover Feline Herpesvirus (abbreviated R), Feline Calicivirus (abbreviated C), Feline Panleukopenia/Infectious Enteritis (abbreviated P), and, where required and advised by your vet, Feline Leukemia Virus (FeLV)



Nobivac combines the RCP vaccs. into Ducat or Tricat Trio (Tricat gives more protection)

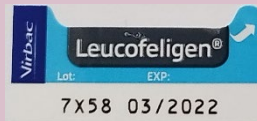
Virbac has a combined vaccination which covers for RCP and FeLV

The FeLV vaccines are given separately where required depending on cat's lifestyle/risk

2nd primary vaccination

At around 12 weeks old (or 4 weeks after the 1st vaccinations if it's a restart)

Stickers will be the same as their 1st vaccinations and need to be of the same brand to provide complete coverage



Cats are fully covered and can come into the cattery **2 weeks after 2nd primary vaccination**

Annual booster

Yearly

RCP, Tricat Trio or Leucofeligen vaccinations required every year
FeLV should be given every one to three years depending on their lifestyle/risk

The course will need to be restarted if the booster is overdue by more than 3 months
